(Mom of 20-something)

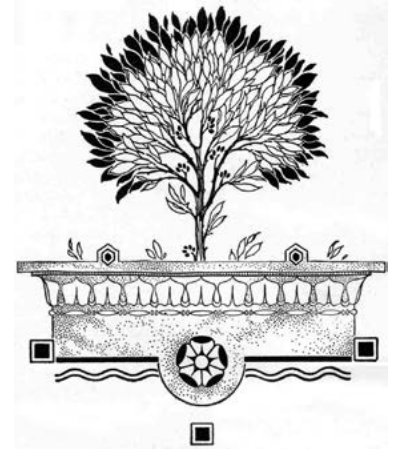
Folded paper place cards
